

CONCLUDING STATEMENT
The Hungarian Autonomous Council of the Carpathian
Basin
Brussels, 1 March 2011

On 1 March 2011 in Brussels the Hungarian Autonomous Council of the Carpathian Basin, embracing the organisations of the Hungarian national communities outside of Hungary, arrived to the following conclusions and decisions:

In unanimity they stated that territorial, personal and special legal status autonomy is the only guarantee for their further existence and development.

To this end they will use all legal means to meet these right expectations and demands of the Hungarian communities.

Such a solution is indispensable from the perspective of the stability of Europe.
